### I Application

- Individual/group-level
- Alignment on the mode (remote/in-person) and timing of education



### I Training

- Duration: 2~3 months
- Lecture & discussion



### I Completion and Follow-up

- Completion Ceremony
- Certification (General/Instructor)
- Pre-/post-surveys to measure the impact
- Sustainable collaboration with the community
- Supplementary education
